CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

House System

To impart a healthy competitive spirit among students and to inculcate the habit of working together and training in leadership qualities, an efficient House System has been introduced in the school. All the students belong to one or the other House guided, cared and controlled by a House Master / Mistress.

It is the responsibility of the House Master / Mistress to look after general progress of their students in academics, games, sports and co-curricular activities.

Since all the competitions are held house wise, house loyalties are strongest. A regular record of pupil's participation and achievements in House activities is maintained and merit points are awarded to each house and student.

ADMISSION AND WITHDRAWALS

Admission Procedures

Admission process upholds the school's tradition of excellence in academic, the arts and athletics. Faculty and authorities share the responsibility for student selection. Student selection is based on academic and non-academic considerations. Admission criteria includes scholastic performance test scores in entrance examination and reports of demonstrated talents and interests. Admissions to other classes are on the basis of a written test and performance in the previous schools.

The age of admission to Kinder Garten is 3 i.e. the child should have completed 3 years on or before 1st June of the year of admission.

The Documents To Be Produced At The Time Of Admission

- Duly completed registration form
- Three passport size photographs (Latest)
- A copy of Birth Certificate (Original to be produced for verification)
- A copy of Aadhar Card (Student, Father & Mother)

Additional Documents To Be Produced By Students Seeking Admission To Class 1st And Above

- Original Transfer Certificate
- Duly attested copy of last school Progress Report Card
- SLC from E-PUNJAB PORTAL (if previous schooling is any where from Punjab State)

Withdrawal Procedures

One month's written notice conveying intention of withdrawal of the child should be submitted to the school authorities. If the application is received in the school office after the first week of the month one month's fees in lieu of notice will be charged.

School Section During Summers


Monday to Saturday 8.00 a.m. to 2.00 p.m.

A Final Word to Our Parents

In order to secure all that is best in the education of your ward the maximum co-operation between parents and school authorities is necessary. We earnestly recommend that parents / guardians look into their children's school diary everyday and see to it that the lessons and home work assigned for the next day are done. Children should be encouraged to cultivate neatness habitually and all slovenliness should be firmly disapproved and remarks made in the diary should be seen and counter signed regularly.

If you feel that your ward does not make the desired progress the Principal / Headmistress should be contacted. Criticism to teacher in their presence should be studiously avoided since it causes the child to lose his respect for his/her teacher with the consequent failure to learn from him / her. Should you have a legitimate complaint meet the Principal / Headmistress.

As your child advances in age, guide him / her to become a resourceful and useful member of home and community.

Encourage self-help for work and study. He / She should be taught to keep his/her room tidy, make-his / her own bed, polish own shoes, carry own bag, etc. the formation of such habits early in life inculcates the ideas of the dignity of labour, a basic human virtue necessary for a successful carrier in life.

Withdrawal of your ward from classes for more social functions is not entertained. As the medium of instruction is English, children should be helped to follow their classes easily and intelligently by a certain amount of regular English conversation at home.
